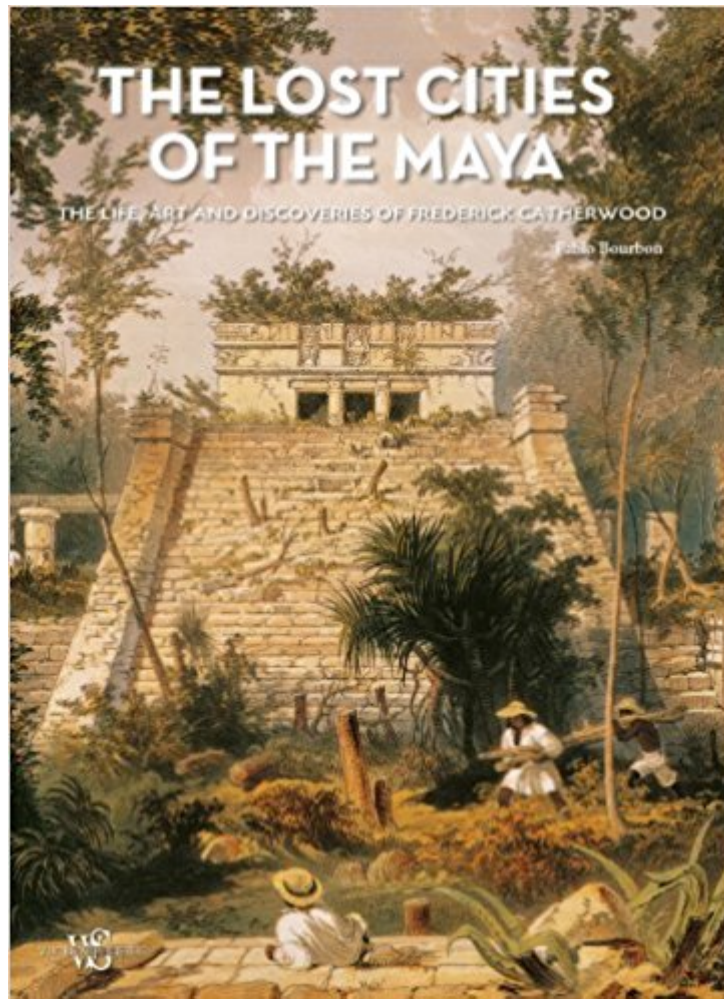


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The Lost Cities Of The Maya: The Life, Art, And Discoveries Of Frederick Catherwood
